Colonel David I. Stamps

Colonel David I. Stamps is the 366th Operations Group Commander, Mountain Home Air Force Base, Idaho. As the commander, he overseas the planning, organizing, training and equipping of military and civilian members conducting flying operations for the F-15E Strike Eagle and Singaporean F-15SG aircraft. The group includes five squadrons responsible for operations, intelligence, weapons training, airfield services, executes airspace and range schedule for more than 20,000 flying hours and 13,000 sorties annually. It also maintains combat readiness for short-



notice worldwide taskings and contingency operations.

Col Stamps completed Officer Training School at Maxwell AFB, AL in 2000. He has served as a Chief of Combat Plans, Flight Commander, Chief of Weapons and Tactics, Assistant Director of Operations, USSTRAT-COM J5 Strategic Planner, Squadron Commander, and HAF A3 Director of Staff. He has flown a variety of aircraft ranging from the T-34, T-1, T-39, T-38, and F-15E. Col Stamps has over 2000flight hours, 463 of which are combat.

Colonel Patrick T. Dierig

Colonel Patrick T. Dierig is Commander of the 479th Flying Training Group at Pensacola Naval Air Station, Fla. The Group includes four squadrons, 325 personnel and 45 T-6 Texan II and T-1A Jayhawk aircraft and trains over 300 Combat Systems Officers each year for the U.S. Air Force, Air Force Reserve Command and Air National Guard. Additionally, the Group supports over 1,500 Air Force personnel in the Pensacola, Fla area.



Prior to assuming his current position, Col. Dierig was a senior program analyst at the Office of Secretary of Defense, Cost Assessment and Program Evaluation (CAPE), Global Shaping Division. Col. Dierig led Department of Defensewide program review and developed program alternatives to address Secretary of Defense priorities. Col. Dierig was a national security fellow at Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government.

Col. Dierig commissioned through officer training school in 2001, after graduating from Xavier University, Cincinnati, Ohio with a Bachelor of Liberal Arts degree. Col. Dierig is a master navigator and electronic warfare officer with more than 2,600 flight hours in the AC-130U and MC-130H. Col. Dierig has flown combat missions in Afghanistan and Iraq; as well as led mission planning cells for joint special operations in South America and Africa.
